

## **SENATE BILL No. 1209**

November 7, 1996, Introduced by Senators CISKY, GAST and CONROY and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of 1929, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for a state-owned and operated radio broadcasting station for police purposes only, and to provide for radio receiving sets to be used in connection therewith; to provide for the purchase of materials and the construction of the necessary apparatus, or the purchase of the required equipment; and to define the powers and duties of the commissioner of the Michigan state police hereunder,"

being sections 28.281, 28.282, and 28.283 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1, 2, and 3 of Act No. 152 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1929, being sections 28.281, 28.282, and 28.283 of
- 3 the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. (1) THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS
- 5 SYSTEM IS CREATED WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.

- 1 (2) The state administrative board is hereby authorized
- 2 -and empowered to purchase the -necessary apparatus BUILDINGS
- 3 and equipment -, and NECESSARY to construct or AND establish
- 4 -- or more radio broadcasting stations -- of which shall be
- 5 erected or established at East Lansing, Michigan, such radio
- 6 broadcasting station or stations shall be used for police pur
- 7 poses only. Said board is further authorized and empowered to
- 8 purchase materials for the construction of radio receiving sets
- 9 and to direct and require the construction of such sets in some
- 10 state owned institution to be designated by such board:
- 11 Provided, however, That if the purchase of material and the con-
- 12 struction of such sets as herein permitted, shall, for any
- 13 reason, be inadvisable, impractical or undesirable, said board
- 14 may authorize the purchase of completed sets TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 15 MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.
- 16 Sec. 2. (1) The -commissioner of the Michigan DIRECTOR OF
- 17 THE DEPARTMENT OF state police is -hereby charged with the IS
- 18 RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ESTABLISHMENT, operation,
- 19 maintenance, and conduct of the said radio broadcasting station
- 20 or stations MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.
- 21 (2) THIS ACT PREEMPTS AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 22 STATE POLICE IS NOT SUBJECT TO ANY LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR REGU-
- 23 LATION THAT RELATES TO THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION, OR OPERATION
- 24 OF RADIO BROADCAST STATIONS AND TOWERS.
- 25 Sec. 3. (1) It shall be the duty of the commissioner of
- 26 the Michigan THE DEPARTMENT OF state police to SHALL broadcast
- 27 all police dispatches and reports -submitted, which -in his

- 1 opinion shall have a reasonable relation to or connection with
- 2 the apprehension of criminals, the prevention of crime, or the
- 3 maintenance of peace and order in this state. -, it being the
- 4 intention of this act to aid and assist peace officers in the
- 5 discharge of their duties.
- 6 (2) THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE MAY CHARGE A REASONABLE
- 7 ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE FEE TO USERS OF THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SAFETY
- 8 COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.
- 9 Section 2. Section 7 of Act No. 152 of the Public Acts of
- 10 1929, being section 28.287 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- ii repealed.
