



# SENATE BILL No. 1216

November 14, 1996, Introduced by Senators GAST and MC MANUS  
and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 33 of chapter 12 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, entitled "Of certain state officers," being section 14.33 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 33 of chapter 12 of the Revised Statutes  
2 of 1846, being section 14.33 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 33. (1) All moneys received by the attorney general,  
5 for debts due, or penalties forfeited to the people of this  
6 state, shall be paid by him OR HER, immediately after ~~the~~  
7 receipt, ~~thereof,~~ into the STATE treasury.

8 (2) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, ANY  
9 PROCEEDS FROM A SETTLEMENT ENTERED INTO BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL  
10 AS THE RESULT OF AN ACTION INSTITUTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ON

1 BEHALF OF THE STATE AGAINST A PRIVATE INDIVIDUAL OR BUSINESS OR  
2 ANY OTHER PRIVATE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO A  
3 RESTRICTED FUND TO BE USED AS PROVIDED BY LAW. IN CASE OF A CON-  
4 FLICT BETWEEN THIS SECTION AND ANOTHER STATE OR FEDERAL LAW THAT  
5 REQUIRES ALLOCATION TO A SPECIFIC FUND OR ACCOUNT OR FOR A SPE-  
6 CIFIC PURPOSE OR PURPOSES, THAT OTHER STATE STATUTE OR FEDERAL  
7 LAW SHALL PREVAIL.

8 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PROCEEDS" MEANS A CASH  
9 SETTLEMENT. PROCEEDS DOES NOT INCLUDE REAL PROPERTY OR STOCKS,  
10 BONDS, OR OTHER EVIDENCES OF INDEBTEDNESS UNLESS THESE ITEMS ARE  
11 TO BE CONVERTED INTO CASH AS PART OF THE SETTLEMENT.
