### **A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4471 AS INTRODUCED 3-11-97**

The bill would amend the Insurance Code to specify, generally speaking, that in cases in which an auto insurance policy is coordinated with a health insurance plan, the auto insurer is liable for reasonable charges incurred for reasonably necessary products, services, and accommodations not covered by the health insurance plan if the products, services, or accommodations were provided by a health care provider licensed, certified, or registered under the Public Health Code. (The bill refers to a health insurance policy, certificate, or contract, or health benefit plan.)
