**A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4647 AS INTRODUCED 4-17-97**

House Bill 4647 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to require the secretary of state to develop and offer applicants the option of obtaining a white-tailed deer vehicle registration plate, instead of a standard registration plate. Those making application for the new registration plate that would bear a white-tailed deer image would be required to follow all existing motor vehicle registration and re-registration procedures (as specified in sections 257.217 and 257.226 of the code), except that upon renewal of the plate, a \$20 service fee above the cost of producing the plate would be charged. All money received as service fees would be deposited in a separate account in the Michigan Transportation Fund, to be used exclusively for removing dead animals from state highways.

House Bill 4647 also would require the secretary of state, in conjunction with the Department of Management and Budget, to solicit competitive bids for the purchase of reflective sheeting from which to manufacture white-tailed deer registration plates.
