A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4687 AS INTRODUCED 4-24-97

The Nonprofit Health Care Corporation Reform Act, which regulates Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Michigan (BCBSM), specifies that no more than 25 percent of the board of directors for a nonprofit health care corporation may be health care providers. Additionally, the act requires that at least one of the provider directors be a registered professional nurse and at least one other provider director be representative of a provider whose services generated the largest number of benefit claims received by the corporation from its subscribers. The remaining provider directors are required to be as broadly representative of provider classes as possible. House Bill 4687 would amend the act to require that at least one of the provider directors be a licensed chiropractor.
