## A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4733 AS INTRODUCED 4-30-97

The bill would create a new act that would designate the trillium *(Trillium grandiflorum, L.)* as the official state flower and the wild crab apple tree (*Malus cornonaria, L.*) as the official state tree. The bill also would repeal the 1897 Joint Resolution 10 (MCL 2.11), which designated and adopted the apple blossom as the state flower, and Public Act 7 of 1955 (MCL 2.31), which adopted the white pine (*Pinus strobus, L.*) as the official state tree.
