A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5074 AS INTRODUCED 9-23-97

The bill would amend the McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely Lottery Act to prohibit the lottery commissioner from conducting a lottery, allowing lottery tickets to be sold, or drawing winning lottery tickets on a Sunday.
