A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5343 AS INTRODUCED 10-30-97

Currently, Part 435 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (NREPA), which regulates hunting and fishing licensing, specifies that a hunter who is carrying a hunting weapon in the field must have a license in his or her possession. House Bill 5343 would amend Part 435 to specify that this requirement would not apply if a person were engaged in target practice or practice with silhouettes, skeet, or trap for sport shooting practice on his or her own property, regardless of whether or not it was open hunting season.
