## INSURANCE ADJUSTER LICENSING

### **A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5606 AS INTRODUCED 2-24-98**

The Insurance Code contains provisions regarding the licensing of insurance adjusters. Currently the code says the insurance commissioner shall not issue a new license or accept an annual license fee continuing a current license to a person residing in a state that denies a comparable license to a resident of Michigan solely because of residency. The bill would add that a new license could not be issued or a fee accepted to continue a current license in the case of a person who received his or her initial adjuster's license in a state that denies a comparable license to a resident of Michigan solely because of residency, if that person is still licensed as an adjuster in that state.
