A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5814 AS INTRODUCED 4-30-98

The Michigan Vehicle Code (MCL 257.319 et al.) provides for the mandatory suspension or revocation of a person's license when that person is convicted of alcohol-related driving offenses. House Bill 5814 would expand these provisions to specify that, when a person was convicted of an alcohol-related driving offense, the secretary of state or the courts would also be required to suspend a person's privilege to operate a vessel, ORV, and snowmobile for the same period. House Bill 5814 is tie-barred to House Bill 5813, which would add this provision to the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act (MCL 324.80186a et al.).
