CONTENT

The bill would amend Public Act 189 of 1953 (which provides for the taxation of for-profit lessees and users of tax-exempt real property) to exclude a casino from the tax exemption allowed under the Act for real property located in a renaissance zone. "Casino" would mean a casino or a parking lot, hotel, motel, or retail store owned or operated by a casino, an affiliate, or an affiliated company, regulated by the State under the Michigan Gaming Control and Revenue Act.
