SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5103

A bill to amend 1978 PA 639, entitled "Hertel-Law-T. Stopczynski port authority act," by amending section 5 (MCL 120.105).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) Except as provided in subsection (5), an
- 2 authority shall consist of 5 or 7 members as follows:
- 3 (a) One member shall be appointed by the governor.
- 4 (b) The remaining members shall be appointed by the govern-
- 5 ing body of each city and the governing body of each county that
- 6 requested the incorporation of the authority. The representation
- 7 on, and the number of members of, the authority shall be deter-
- 8 mined by agreement among the incorporating units and included
- 9 within the joint resolution requesting incorporation of the
- 10 authority.

- 1 (2) The members first appointed shall serve staggered
- 2 terms. Thereafter, each member shall serve for a term of 4
- 3 years, except that a person appointed to fill a vacancy shall be
- 4 appointed for the balance of the unexpired term. A member shall
- **5** be eligible for reappointment.
- 6 (3) The members shall elect 1 of their membership as chair-
- 7 person and another as vice-chairperson, shall designate their
- 8 terms of office, and shall appoint a secretary-treasurer who need
- 9 not be a member. A majority of the members of the authority
- 10 shall constitute a quorum, the affirmative vote of which shall be
- 11 necessary for any action taken by the authority. However, the
- 12 authority shall not commit funds of a constituent entity without
- 13 the concurrence of the member representing that entity. A unani-
- 14 mous vote of the members of the authority, which may be accom-
- 15 plished by written consent of an absent member, shall be required
- 16 to approve an operating budget or capital outlay.
- 17 (4) The members shall serve without compensation but shall
- 18 be reimbursed for all necessary travel and other expenses
- 19 incurred in the discharge of their duties.
- 20 (5) An authority which is established in a county having a
- 21 population of $\frac{2,000,000}{1,500,000}$ or more shall consist of 5
- 22 members as follows:
- 23 (a) One member shall be appointed by the governor.
- 24 (b) Two members shall be appointed by a majority of all the
- 25 members of the county board of commissioners of the county. The

- 1 board who do not reside within the political boundaries of a city
- 2 having a population of $\frac{1,000,000}{750,000}$ 750,000 or more.
- 3 (c) Two members shall be appointed by the mayor of a city
- 4 having a population of $\frac{1,000,000}{750,000}$ 750,000 or more which is
- 5 located in the county.
