THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 25. (1) THE BUREAU SHALL GIVE A PRIZEWINNER THE OPTION
- 2 OF RECEIVING HIS OR HER PRIZE IN A SINGLE PAYMENT OR IN
- 3 INSTALLMENTS. [THIS OPTION SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO AND EXERCISED BY THE PURCHASER OF THE TICKET AT THE POINT OF PURCHASE.]
- 4 (2) $\overline{(1)}$ The right of any person to a prize drawn from the
- 5 state lottery is not assignable, except that payment of any prize
- 6 drawn may be paid to the family members or to the estate of a
- 7 deceased prizewinner as provided in subsection $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$, to a
- 8 person pursuant to an appropriate judicial order, or to the state
- 9 pursuant to section 32. The commissioner shall be discharged of

- (3) $\overline{(2)}$ If a prizewinner dies before collecting the full
- 2 amount of his or her prize drawn from the state lottery, the
- 3 bureau shall continue to make the remaining prize payments to the
- 4 prizewinner's surviving spouse and the prizewinner's living chil-
- 5 dren, in equal proportions, unless otherwise directed by the
- 6 prizewinner. If there is not a surviving spouse or living chil-
- 7 dren or other designated beneficiaries, the remaining prize pay-
- 8 ments shall be made to the prizewinner's estate.
