

SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 5289

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled  
"Emergency telephone service enabling act,"  
by amending sections 320 and 703 (MCL 484.1320 and 484.1730),  
section 320 as added and section 703 as amended by 1994 PA 29.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 320. (1) The county shall create an emergency tele-  
2 phone district board if a county creates a consolidated dispatch  
3 within an emergency telephone district after ~~the effective date~~  
4 ~~of the amendatory act that added this section~~ MARCH 2, 1994.

5       (2) The membership of the board and the board's powers and  
6 duties shall be determined by the county board of commissioners.  
7 However, the membership of the board shall include a representa-  
8 tive of the county sheriff or his or her designated  
9 representative, ~~and~~ a representative of the Michigan state  
10 police designated by the director of the Michigan state police,

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1 AND A FIREFIGHTER. If the emergency telephone district consists  
2 of more than 1 county, the sheriff representative shall be  
3 appointed by the president of the Michigan sheriffs'  
4 association.

5 (3) A county or other public agency may make appropriations  
6 to the emergency telephone district board.

7 (4) A public agency may contract with the emergency tele-  
8 phone district board, and persons who are both members of the  
9 board and of the governing body of the public agency may vote  
10 both on the board and the body if approved by the contract.

11 (5) The basis under which a consolidated dispatch meets the  
12 requirement for being a dispatch under section 102(c) shall  
13 determine the system to be used in dispatching participating  
14 service units.

15 Sec. 703. (1) The committee shall consist of ~~17~~ 18 mem-  
16 bers as follows:

17 (a) The director of the department of state police or his or  
18 her designated representative.

19 (b) The director of ~~public~~ COMMUNITY health or his or her  
20 designated representative.

21 (c) The chair of the Michigan public service commission or  
22 his or her designated representative.

23 (d) The president of the Michigan sheriffs' association or  
24 his or her designated representative.

25 (e) The president of the Michigan association of chiefs of  
26 police or his or her designated representative.

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1 (f) The president of the Michigan fire chiefs association or  
2 his or her designated representative.

3 (g) The executive director of the Michigan association of  
4 counties or his or her designated representative.

5 (h) The executive director of the deputy sheriffs associa-  
6 tion of Michigan or his or her designated representative.

7 (i) Three members of the general public, 1 member to be  
8 appointed by the governor, 1 member to be appointed by the  
9 speaker of the house of representatives, and 1 member to be  
10 appointed by the majority leader of the senate. The 3 members of  
11 the general public shall have expertise relating to emergency  
12 radio communications, dispatching, and services or to telephone  
13 systems. The members of the general public shall serve for terms  
14 of 2 years. One member appointed pursuant to this subdivision  
15 shall be a representative of the Michigan center of rural  
16 health.

17 (j) The executive director of the Michigan fraternal order  
18 of police or his or her designated representative.

19 (k) The president of the Michigan state police troopers  
20 association or his or her designated representative.

21 (l) The president of the Michigan chapter of the associated  
22 public safety communications officers or his or her designated  
23 representative.

24 (m) The president of the Michigan chapter of the national  
25 emergency number association or his or her designated  
26 representative.

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1       (n) The president of the telephone association of Michigan  
2 or his or her designated representative.

3       (o) The executive director of the Upper Peninsula emergency  
4 medical services corporation or his or her designated  
5 representative.

6       (P) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MICHIGAN STATE FIREFIGHTERS UNION  
7 OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE.

8       (2) The committee shall elect 1 of its members to serve as  
9 chairperson. The chairperson of the committee shall serve for a  
10 term of 1 year.

11       (3) The committee may adopt, amend, and rescind bylaws,  
12 rules, and regulations for the conduct of its business.

13       (4) Members of the committee shall serve without compensa-  
14 tion, but shall be entitled to actual and necessary expenses  
15 incurred in the performance of official duties under this  
16 chapter.
