## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4047

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 3112b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 3112B. (1) WHEN A PERMIT FOR A DISCHARGE FROM A COM-
- 2 BINED SEWER SYSTEM IS ISSUED OR RENEWED UNDER THIS PART, THE
- 3 DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE AS A CONDITION OF THE PERMIT THAT EAVES
- 4 TROUGHS AND ROOF DOWNSPOUTS FOR THE COLLECTION OF STORM WATER
- 5 THROUGHOUT THE TRIBUTARY SERVICE AREA ARE NOT DIRECTLY CONNECTED
- 6 TO THE SEWER SYSTEM. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW THE PERMITTEE UP
- 7 TO 1 YEAR TO COMPLY WITH THIS PROVISION FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY
- 8 AND UP TO 5 YEARS FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PROPERTIES.
- 9 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY IF THE PERMITTEE
- 10 DEMONSTRATES TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT THE
- 11 DISCONNECTION OF DOWNSPOUTS AND EAVES TROUGHS IS NOT A

## HB 4047, As Passed Senate, December 10, 1997

House Bill No. 4047

- 1 COST-EFFECTIVE MEANS OF REDUCING THE FREQUENCY OR DURATION OF
- 2 COMBINED SEWER OVERFLOWS OR OF MAINTAINING COMPLIANCE WITH DIS-
- 3 CHARGE REQUIREMENTS.
- 4 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "COMBINED SEWER SYSTEM" MEANS A
- 5 SEWER DESIGNED AND USED TO CONVEY BOTH STORM WATER RUNOFF AND
- 6 SANITARY SEWAGE, AND WHICH CONTAINS LAWFULLY INSTALLED REGULATORS
- 7 AND CONTROL DEVICES THAT ALLOW FOR DELIVERY OF SANITARY FLOW TO
- 8 TREATMENT DURING DRY WEATHER PERIODS AND DIVERT STORM WATER AND
- 9 SANITARY SEWAGE TO SURFACE WATERS DURING STORM FLOW PERIODS.
