- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "the

- **5** PA 368, MCL 333.16274.
- 6 Sec. 3. A person shall not use state funds to engage in or

- 8 Sec. 4. Section 3 does not prohibit the use of state funds
- 9 for scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically
- 10 prohibited by that section.
- 11 Sec. 5. This act does not give a person a private right of
