SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 331

(As Passed the Senate May 7, 1997)

A bill to amend 1956 PA 217, entitled "Electrical administrative act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 338.885), as amended by 1992 PA 130.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section
- 2 and in section 7, a person, firm, or corporation shall not
- 3 install any electric wiring, devices, appliances, or appurte-
- 4 nances for the generation, distribution, and utilization of elec-
- 5 trical energy, within or on any building, structures, or proper-
- 6 ties, without being licensed. In a municipality where inspection
- 7 service is provided, a permit shall be obtained from the board or
- 8 municipality having jurisdiction. IF THE ELECTRIC WIRING,
- 9 DEVICES, APPLIANCES, OR APPURTENANCES ARE INSTALLED WITHOUT
- 10 COMPENSATION BY A PERSON LICENSED UNDER THIS ACT FOR OR ON BEHALF
- 11 OF A CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, THE PERMIT REQUIRED UNDER THIS
