

A bill to amend 1984 PA 22, entitled
"Michigan civilian conservation corps act,"
by amending section 6 (MCL 409.306), as amended by 1985 PA 30.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 6. (1) A person is eligible to become a corpsmember if
2 he or she:
3 (a) Is a resident of this state.
4 (b) Except for supervisors, is not less than 18 years of age
5 and not more than 25 years of age on the date of application.
6 (c) Is not employed at the time of hire.
7 (d) Is not a son or daughter of an elected or appointed
8 official of this state or of a city, village, county, township,
9 school district, intermediate school district, or other
10 governmental authority.

1 (e) If employed as a supervisor, was not on the department's
2 or recipient's payroll within 30 days before being hired through
3 a program established with funds received under this act unless
4 he or she was promoted from a general corpsmember to a corps
5 supervisor.

6 (2) If the number of persons applying for positions in a
7 work training program established under this act exceeds the
8 number of positions created, the chief shall give priority in
9 hiring to recipients of general assistance and aid to families
10 with dependent children. In hiring supervisors, the chief also
11 shall give priority to qualified recipients of general assistance
12 and aid to families with dependent children.

13 (3) The chief shall ensure that eligible minority persons,
14 eligible persons who are members of households the heads of which
15 are single, eligible persons ~~who are handicapped~~ WITH
16 DISABILITIES, and equal numbers of eligible males and females, to
17 the extent that these persons apply for the program, are hired as
18 corpsmembers.

19 (4) The chief shall notify the director of the department of
20 social services of any work training program established under
21 this act. The director of the department of social services
22 shall take any action necessary to notify all employable recip-
23 ients of general assistance and aid to families with dependent
24 children who are eligible under this act, who are not currently
25 assigned to employment, training, or an educational program, of
26 the work training programs established under this act.

1 (5) An employable recipient of general assistance or aid to
2 families with dependent children who is eligible for employment
3 under this act and who is not currently assigned to employment,
4 training, or an educational program, who, without good cause,
5 refuses an offer of employment under this act is subject to sec-
6 tion 55a of the social welfare act, ~~Act No. 200 of the Public~~
7 ~~Acts of 1939, being section 400.55a of the Michigan Compiled~~
8 ~~Laws~~ 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.55A.
