**SUBSTITUTE FOR  
SENATE BILL NO. 614**

(As Passed the Senate December 3, 1997)

A bill to amend 1966 PA 331, entitled  
"Community college act of 1966,"  
(MCL 389.1 to 389.195) by adding sections 128, 129, 130, and  
131.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1        SEC. 128. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (2) AND (3), THE BOARD  
2 OF TRUSTEES OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE CREATED UNDER THIS ACT MAY  
3 GRANT TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE OFFICERS OF THAT  
4 COMMUNITY COLLEGE THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF A PEACE OR LAW  
5 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE OFFICERS  
6 GRANTED THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY UNDER THIS ACT SHALL HAVE THE  
7 SAME POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF A PEACE OFFICER UNDER THE CODE OF  
8 CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1927 PA 175, MCL 760.1 TO 776.22, AND AS  
9 PROVIDED UNDER THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1

1 (2) BEFORE GRANTING THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY PROVIDED UNDER  
2 SUBSECTION (1), A BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL  
3 CONDUCT NOT LESS THAN 2 PUBLIC HEARINGS.

4 (3) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL NOT  
5 GRANT THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) UNLESS  
6 THAT BOARD OF TRUSTEES CREATES A PUBLIC SAFETY OVERSIGHT  
7 COMMITTEE. THE PUBLIC SAFETY OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE SHALL BE COM-  
8 PRISED OF 2 MEMBERS OF THE FACULTY AND 2 MEMBERS OF THE STAFF OF  
9 THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE. THE PUBLIC SAFETY OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE  
10 SHALL RECEIVE AND ADDRESS GRIEVANCES BY PERSONS AGAINST THE  
11 PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE OFFICERS OR AGAINST THE PUBLIC  
12 SAFETY DEPARTMENT OR POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THAT COMMUNITY  
13 COLLEGE. THE COMMITTEE MAY RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OR  
14 THE ADMINISTRATION OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE THAT DISCIPLINARY  
15 MEASURES BE TAKEN AGAINST A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER OR POLICE OFFI-  
16 CER WHO IS FOUND RESPONSIBLE FOR MISCONDUCT IN OFFICE.

17 SEC. 129. (1) THE JURISDICTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR  
18 POLICE OFFICERS GRANTED POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF PEACE OR LAW  
19 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS UNDER SECTION 128 SHALL INCLUDE ALL PROPERTY  
20 OWNED OR LEASED BY THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE IN THIS STATE AND  
21 EXTENDS TO THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY TRAVERSING OR CONTIGUOUS TO  
22 THAT PROPERTY.

23 (2) THE JURISDICTION OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE  
24 OFFICERS UNDER SUBSECTION (1) IS LIMITED TO THE PROTECTION OF  
25 PERSONS AND PROPERTY ON THE PROPERTY OF THAT COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
26 UNLESS AN EMERGENCY RESPONSE IS MADE OFF CAMPUS AT THE SPECIFIC  
27 REQUEST OF ANOTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

1           SEC. 130. PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS OR POLICE OFFICERS OF A  
2 COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO WHOM THE POWERS AND AUTHORITY OF A PEACE OR  
3 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ARE GRANTED UNDER SECTION 1 SHALL MEET  
4 THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE MICHIGAN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS  
5 TRAINING COUNCIL ACT OF 1965, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 TO 28.616.

6           SEC. 131. THE PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT OR POLICE DEPARTMENT  
7 OF EACH COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL SUBMIT MONTHLY UNIFORM CRIME  
8 REPORTS PERTAINING TO CRIMES WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION  
9 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 OF  
10 1968 PA 319, MCL 28.251.

11           Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take  
12 effect unless all of the following bills of the 89th Legislature  
13 are enacted into law:
