- 4 the securing of, 1 or more licenses, the court may order the
- 5 revocation of 1 or more of the person's licenses and may by order
- 6 provide that the person shall not secure 1 or more licenses for
- 7 not less than the remainder of the year in which convicted and
- 8 during the next succeeding year, or longer in the discretion of
- 9 the court.
