

**HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 800**

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 43559 (MCL 324.43559), as amended by 1996 PA
585.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 43559. (1) If a person is convicted of violating this
2 part, or another law relative to hunting, fishing, or trapping
3 that does not otherwise require the revocation of, or prohibit
4 the securing of, 1 or more licenses, the court may order the
5 revocation of 1 or more of the person's licenses and may by order
6 provide that the person shall not secure 1 or more licenses for
7 not less than the remainder of the year in which convicted and
8 during the next succeeding year, or longer in the discretion of
9 the court.

1 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COMPLY WITH A SUSPENSION ORDER
2 ISSUED AS PROVIDED IN THE SUPPORT AND PARENTING TIME ENFORCEMENT
3 ACT, 1982 PA 295, MCL 552.601 TO 552.650, WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER
4 RECEIPT OF THE SUSPENSION ORDER.

5 (3) AN ORDER RESCINDING A SUSPENSION ORDER ISSUED UNDER THE
6 SUPPORT AND PARENTING TIME ENFORCEMENT ACT, 1982 PA 295, MCL
7 552.601 TO 552.650, IS EFFECTIVE UPON ITS ENTRY BY THE COURT AND
8 PURCHASE BY THE LICENSEE OF A REPLACEMENT LICENSE.
