**SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 6**

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 217b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 217B. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT EMPLOYED BY A
2 PUBLIC UTILITY SHALL NOT INFORM ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL OR REPRESENT
3 TO ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL BY UNIFORM, IDENTIFICATION, OR ANY OTHER
4 MEANS THAT HE OR SHE IS EMPLOYED BY A PUBLIC UTILITY WITH INTENT
5 TO DO 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) GAIN OR ATTEMPT TO GAIN ENTRY TO A RESIDENCE, BUILDING,
7 STRUCTURE, FACILITY, OR OTHER PROPERTY.
- 8 (B) REMAIN OR ATTEMPT TO REMAIN IN OR UPON A RESIDENCE,
9 BUILDING, STRUCTURE, FACILITY, OR OTHER PROPERTY.
- 10 (C) COMMIT OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME.

1 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
2 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR A
3 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

4 (3) THE COURT MAY IMPOSE A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT UNDER THIS
5 SECTION TO BE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY TO ANY TERM OF IMPRISONMENT
6 IMPOSED FOR A CONVICTION OF A CRIME OR ATTEMPT TO COMMIT A CRIME
7 ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION OR RESULTING FROM THE
8 VIOLATION.

9 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC UTILITY" MEANS A UTIL-
10 ITY THAT PROVIDES STEAM, GAS, HEAT, ELECTRICITY, WATER, CABLE
11 TELEVISION, TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES, OR PIPELINE SERVICES,
12 WHETHER PRIVATELY, MUNICIPALLY, OR COOPERATIVELY OWNED.
Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect June 1, 1997.
