## SENATE BILL NO. 683

September 24, 1997, Introduced by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Financial Services.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 319, entitled "Banking code of 1969,"

by amending section 171 (MCL 487.471), as amended by 1997 PA 49.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 171. (1) Upon written notice to the commissioner, a
- 2 bank may establish and operate a branch or branches within any
- 3 state, the District of Columbia, or a territory or protectorate
- 4 of the United States unless the commissioner objects in writing
- 5 within 60 days after receipt of the written notice from the
- 6 bank. The commissioner may issue a written statement of intent
- 7 not to object at any time before the expiration of the 60 days.
- **8** (2) The notice of intent to establish a mobile branch shall
- 9 contain a statement by the applying bank that it intends to move
- 10 the location of the physical structure of the branch from time to
- 11 time.

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- 1 (3) Except for a mobile branch, a branch of a bank shall not2 be moved from 1 location to another without 30 days advance writ-
- 3 ten notice to the commissioner.
- 4 (4) Upon written notice to the commissioner, a bank may con-
- 5 tract with 1 or more banks, out-of-state banks, national banks,
- 6 associations, or savings banks to act as a branch to provide
- 7 services to the customers of the contracting bank unless the com-
- 8 missioner objects in writing within 60 days after receipt of the
- 9 written notice from the bank. The commissioner may issue a writ-
- 10 ten statement of intent not to object at any time prior to the
- 11 expiration of the 60 days. This subsection shall not be con-
- 12 strued to limit the powers granted to a bank under
- **13** section 151(31).
- 14 (5) Upon written notice to the commissioner, 1 or more
- 15 out-of-state banks, national banks, associations, or savings
- 16 banks may contract with a bank to provide services to the custom-
- 17 ers of the contracting out-of-state bank, national bank, associa-
- 18 tion, or savings bank, unless the commissioner objects in writing
- 19 within 60 days after receipt of the written notice. The commis-
- 20 sioner may issue a written statement of intent not to object at
- 21 any time before the expiration of the 60 days. This subsection
- 22 shall not be construed to limit the powers granted to a bank
- 23 under section 151(31).
- 24 (6) Subject to the requirements, limitations, and restric-
- 25 tions of subsections (1) to (3), a state agency or state foreign
- 26 bank branch organized under this act may establish and operate

- 1 additional offices in the United States and its territories and
  2 protectorates.
- 3 (7) An out-of-state bank, FOREIGN BANK BRANCH, OR NATIONAL
- 4 BANK located in a state, the District of Columbia, or a territory
- 5 or protectorate of the United States whose laws permit the estab-
- 6 lishment in that state, district, territory, or protectorate of a
- 7 branch by a bank may establish and operate 1 or more branches in
- 8 this state.
- **9** (8) An out-of-state bank may apply to organize a branch in
- 10 this state under this act by providing to the commissioner proof
- 11 that its deposits are insured by an agency of the United States
- 12 government. If the commissioner determines after receipt of
- 13 this proof and the notices required under subsections (9) and
- 14 (14), that the out-of-state bank is safe and sound, that the
- 15 out-of-state bank is subject to regulation, and that there exists
- 16 an agreement for exchange of supervisory information between the
- 17 bureau and the out-of-state bank's regulator, the commissioner
- 18 shall provide to the out-of-state bank a certificate of organiza-
- 19 tion and eligibility to accept deposits and investments of public
- 20 funds of the state and local units of government.
- 21 (9) An out-of-state bank operating in this state shall des-
- 22 ignate and maintain an agent located in this state upon whom pro-
- 23 cess for judicial and administrative matters may be served and
- 24 shall provide written notice containing the name and address of
- 25 its agent to the commissioner before commencing operations in
- 26 this state.

- 1 (10) An out-of-state bank operating in this state shall
- 2 notify the commissioner in writing of any change in its
- 3 designated agent or the agent's address within 10 days following
- 4 the effective date of the change.
- (9) (11) A foreign bank branch that has designated a home
- 6 state other than Michigan may establish and operate 1 or more
- 7 additional offices in this state.
- 8 (10)  $\frac{(12)}{(12)}$  A foreign bank operating in this state shall
- 9 designate and maintain an agent located in this state upon whom
- 10 process for judicial and administrative matters may be served and
- 11 shall provide written notice containing the name and address of
- 12 its agent to the commissioner before commencing operations in
- 13 this state.
- 14 (11)  $\frac{(13)}{(13)}$  A foreign bank operating in this state shall
- 15 notify the commissioner in writing of any change in its desig-
- 16 nated agent or the agent's address within 10 days following the
- 17 effective date of the change.
- 18 (12)  $\frac{(14)}{(14)}$  Prior to commencing operations at a branch in
- 19 this state, an out-of-state bank or national bank shall file with
- 20 the commissioner the ITS name, of the bank, the street
- 21 address and mailing address, if different, of the bank's ITS
- 22 principal office, the street address of the branch office, and
- 23 the date when the branch is to commence operations in this
- 24 state.
- 25 (13)  $\frac{(15)}{}$  An out-of-state bank and national bank operating
- 26 in this state shall designate and maintain an agent located in
- 27 this state upon whom process for judicial and administrative

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- 1 matters may be served and shall provide written notice containing
- 2 the name and address of its agent to the commissioner before com-
- 3 mencing operations in this state.
- 4 (14) -(16) An out-of-state bank or national bank operating
- 5 in this state shall notify the commissioner in writing of any
- 6 change in its designated agent or the agent's address within 10
- 7 days following the effective date of the change.
