

# HOUSE BILL No. 4011

January 8, 1997, Introduced by Rep. Fitzgerald and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
section 7a of chapter VIII (MCL 768.7a), as amended by 1988 PA  
48.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 7a. (1) A person who is incarcerated in OR ESCAPES  
2 FROM a penal or reformatory institution in this state ~~, or who~~  
3 ~~escapes from such an institution,~~ and who commits a crime during  
4 that incarceration or escape ~~which~~ THAT is punishable by  
5 imprisonment in a penal or reformatory institution in this state  
6 shall ~~, upon conviction of that crime,~~ be sentenced as provided  
7 by law UPON CONVICTION OF THAT CRIME. The term of imprisonment  
8 imposed for the crime shall begin to run at the expiration of the  
9 term or terms of imprisonment ~~which~~ the person is serving or

1 has become liable to serve in a penal or reformatory institution  
2 in this state.

3       (2) If a person is convicted and sentenced to a term of  
4 imprisonment for a felony committed while the person was on  
5 parole from a sentence for a previous offense, the term of  
6 imprisonment imposed for the later offense shall begin to run at  
7 the expiration of the remaining portion of the MAXIMUM term of  
8 imprisonment imposed for the previous offense OR 1 YEAR, WHICH-  
9 EVER IS LESS.

10       (3) The powers conferred upon the court by this section are  
11 supplementary to any other power conferred by law.
