- 7 person or property of other, shall be ANOTHER IS guilty of a
- 8 felony -, punishable AND SHALL BE PUNISHED by imprisonment -in
- 9 the state prison for not less than 2 $\overline{}$ nor YEARS OR more than 10 $\overline{}$ 15 years.

- 1 Sec. 211. Manufacture, etc., of explosives with intent to
- 2 use unlawfully--Any A person who shall manufacture, buy, sell,
