

HOUSE BILL No. 4095

January 28, 1997, Introduced by Rep. Curtis and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 809 (MCL 257.809), as amended by 1987 PA
238.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 809. (1) An application for transfer of registration
2 from a vehicle subject to section 801(1)(a) to another vehicle
3 subject to that section shall be accompanied by a fee of \$8.00.
4 In addition to the fee of \$8.00, if the registration is trans-
5 ferred from a passenger vehicle to a motor home and if the regis-
6 tration fee for the motor home is greater than the fee paid upon
7 registration of the vehicle from which the registration was
8 removed, then the difference in fee shall be paid by the
9 applicant. If the fee is less than that paid for the
10 registration of the vehicle from which the plates were removed,

1 the difference shall not be refunded. The fees required by this
2 subsection shall be considered to include all fees or charges
3 imposed by this act for the transfer of registration, except
4 those which may be assessed by section 234.

5 (2) An application for a transfer of registration, other
6 than a transfer described in subsection (1), shall be accompanied
7 by a fee of \$8.00. In addition to the fee of \$8.00, if the reg-
8 istration plates are transferred to another vehicle, as provided
9 in section 233, and if the plate fee for a 12-month registration
10 for the vehicle to which the registration is transferred is
11 greater than the plate fee paid upon registration of the vehicle
12 from which the registration was removed, then the difference
13 shall be paid by the applicant for the new registration. If the
14 fee is less than that paid for registration of the vehicle from
15 which the registration was removed, the difference shall not be
16 refunded.

17 (3) AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION FROM A
18 PARENT TO A CHILD OF THE PARENT WHO IS LESS THAN 21 YEARS OF AGE
19 AND WHO IS RESIDING WITH THE PARENT IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE FEE
20 REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.
