- 3 AN UNFAIR METHOD OF COMPETITION AND AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACT OR
- 4 PRACTICE IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE:
- 5 (A) THE HEPATITIS B VIRUS.
- 6 (B) THE HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS.
- 7 (C) A RECORD OF 1 OR MORE PHYSICAL INJURIES SUSTAINED BY THE
- 8 INSURED OR APPLICANT FOR INSURANCE THAT WERE INTENTIONALLY
- 9 INFLICTED BY A FAMILY MEMBER OR ACQUAINTANCE OF THE INSURED OR
- 10 APPLICANT FOR INSURANCE.
