- 2 DECEPTIVE METHODS, ACTS, OR PRACTICES IN THE CONDUCT OF TRADE OR
- 3 COMMERCE DEFINED IN SECTION 3, IT IS A VIOLATION OF THIS ACT FOR
- 4 A PERSON TO SELL WINDOW BLINDS IN THIS STATE AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 5 DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION THAT DO NOT
- 6 INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) CLEATS, HARDWARE, AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLATION THAT
- 8 WOULD ALLOW THE WINDOW BLIND CORD TO BE SECURED.
- 9 (B) A WARNING ABOUT THE DANGER OF ACCIDENTAL HANGING OR
- 10 STRANGULATION FROM A WINDOW BLIND CORD THAT IS NOT SECURED.
