THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 215. Any person who falsely assumes or pretends to be a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation officer, coroner, constable, police officer, or member of the Michigan state police, and shall take upon himself or herself to act as such, or to require any person to aid and assist him or her in any matter pertaining to the duty of a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation officer, coroner, constable, police officer, or member of the Michigan state police, or shall falsely take upon himself or herself to act or officiate in any office or place of authority, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more

- 6 (iv) A POLICE OFFICER OF A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WHO IS
- 7 AUTHORIZED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THAT COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY TO
- 8 ENFORCE THE CRIMINAL LAWS OF THIS STATE.
