HOUSE BILL No. 5839

May 12, 1998, Introduced by Reps. Richner, Scranton and Varga and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1929 PA 297, entitled

"An act to provide for vacating private and public cemetery plats and cemetery grounds in the limits of incorporated cities and villages and to provide for the acquisition by said cities and villages of the cemetery grounds and plats vacated hereunder,"

by amending sections 1, 2, and 5 (MCL 128.51, 128.52, and 128.55).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) That, whenever the THE trustees of an incor-
- 2 porated village or the common council of any city, shall,
- 3 by a resolution adopted by them, determine MAY DO EITHER OF THE

- 6 COMMON COUNCIL IN THE circuit court in chancery of the county

- 3 the proceedings upon such reference shall, so far as practicable,
