- 5 NOT MORE THAN \$50.00 FOR EACH OFFENSE.
- 6 (2) PURSUANT TO A PROBATION ORDER, THE COURT MAY REQUIRE A
- 7 PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) TO PARTICIPATE IN A HEALTH
- 8 PROMOTION AND RISK REDUCTION ASSESSMENT PROGRAM, IF AVAILABLE. A
