THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 136C. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO
- 2 KNOW THAT A CRIME OF VIOLENCE IS BEING COMMITTED AGAINST AN INDI-
- 3 VIDUAL WHO IS LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE SHALL IMMEDIATELY REPORT
- 4 THAT CRIME TO A POLICE AGENCY HAVING JURISDICTION OVER THAT
- 5 CRIME.
- 6 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 7 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF
- 8 NOT MORE THAN \$2,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 9 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CRIME OF VIOLENCE" MEANS A
- 10 CRIME INVOLVING THE USE OF FORCE OR THE THREAT OF USE OF FORCE
- 11 AGAINST ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL.
