May 15, 1997, Introduced by Senator DINGELL and referred to the Committee on Economic Development, International Trade and Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend 1933 (Ex Sess) PA 8, entitled "The Michigan liquor control act," by amending section 4 (MCL 436.4).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. Exceptions to act. The provisions of this THIS
- 2 act shall DOES not be construed to prevent the APPLY TO THE

- 4 (A) THE manufacture of cider from fruit —, for the purpose

- 15 (G) THE purchase of alcoholic liquor as defined in this
- 16 act, for use in the manufacture of toilet, medicinal, or anti-
- 17 septic preparations or solutions, or any flavoring extract or
- 18 patent or proprietary medicines or preparations, by a manufac-
- 19 turer using -such alcoholic liquor exclusively for -such THE
- 20 manufacturing purposes and duly licensed therefor by the com-
- 21 mission ; said FOR THAT USE. A license to expire on May first
- 22 following the date of issuance, issued -on FOR THAT USE IS
- 23 PREDICATED UPON the payment of an annual fee of 10 dollars
- 24 \$10.00 and the furnishing of such A bond or bonds as the com-
- 25 mission may require REQUIRES running to the people of the state
- 26 of Michigan, for the faithful performance of the conditions of

- 1 the license and compliance with the provisions of this act.
- 2 THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON MAY 1 FOLLOWING THE DATE OF ITS ISSUANCE.
- 3 (H) THE POSSESSION OR RECEIPT AS A GIFT OF NOT MORE THAN 20
- 4 GALLONS OF HOME-BREWED OR CRAFT-BREWED BEER, HOME-MADE WINE, OR
- 5 HOME-MADE CIDER CONTAINING ALCOHOL.
