## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43536. (1) A resident of this state who is 65 years
- 2 of age or older may obtain a senior restricted fishing license.
- 3 The fee for a senior restricted fishing license is discounted 60%
- 4 from the fee for a resident restricted fishing license.
- 5 (1)  $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$  A resident of this state who is 65 years of age or
- 6 older may obtain a senior all-species fishing license. The fee
- 7 for a senior all-species fishing license is discounted 60% from
- 8 the fee for a resident all species RESTRICTED fishing license.
