

SENATE BILL NO. 612

June 24, 1997, Introduced by Senator DINGELL and referred
to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 306, entitled
"Administrative procedures act of 1969,"
(MCL 24.201 to 24.328) by adding section 24a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 24A. IF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE RULES,
2 AN APPROPRIATE STANDING COMMITTEE, OR A MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE
3 BELIEVES THAT AN ADOPTED GUIDELINE OR ANY PART OF AN ADOPTED
4 GUIDELINE IS UNAUTHORIZED, IS NOT WITHIN LEGISLATIVE INTENT, OR
5 IS INEXPEDIENT, THE COMMITTEE OR MEMBER MAY DO EITHER OR BOTH OF
6 THE FOLLOWING:
7 (A) INTRODUCE A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AT A REGULAR OR SPE-
8 CIAL SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE EXPRESSING THE DETERMINATION OF
9 THE LEGISLATURE THAT THE GUIDELINE SHOULD BE AMENDED OR
10 RESCINDED. ADOPTION OF THE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTES
11 LEGISLATIVE DISAPPROVAL OF THE GUIDELINE, BUT REJECTION OF THE

1 RESOLUTION DOES NOT CONSTITUTE LEGISLATIVE APPROVAL OF THE
2 GUIDELINE.

3 (B) INTRODUCE A BILL AT A REGULAR SESSION, OR SPECIAL SES-
4 SION IF INCLUDED IN A GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE, THAT IN EFFECT AMENDS
5 OR RESCINDS THE GUIDELINE.
