

SENATE BILL NO. 637

June 26, 1997, Introduced by Senators STILLE, BENNETT, SHUGARS, GOUGEON, DUNASKISS, BYRUM, SCHWARZ, STEIL, BULLARD, MC MANUS, CISKY, HOFFMAN, KOIVISTO, MILLER, CHERRY, DE BEAUSSAERT, PETERS, DINGELL, CONROY, HART and NORTH and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend 1991 PA 179, entitled
"Michigan telecommunications act,"
(MCL 484.2101 to 484.2604) by adding section 375.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

ARTICLE 3B

4 WITHIN THIS STATE WHICH RECEIVE FEDERAL UNIVERSAL SERVICE SUPPORT
5 FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES PROVIDED TO ELIGIBLE ELEMENTARY
6 AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES, UNDER THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS
7 ACT OF 1996, PUBLIC LAW 104-104, 110 STAT. 56, SHALL PROVIDE
8 THOSE INTRASTATE SERVICES AT DISCOUNTS EQUAL TO THE DISCOUNTS
9 APPLICABLE FOR ELIGIBLE INTERSTATE SERVICES.
