

SENATE BILL NO. 669

July 10, 1997, Introduced by Senator BOUCHARD and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 295, entitled "Sex offenders registration act," by amending sections 5 and 7 (MCL 28.725 and 28.727), section 7 as amended by 1996 PA 494.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 5. (1) Within 10 days after any of the following
2 occur, an individual required to be registered under this act
3 shall notify the local law enforcement agency ~~in which~~ OR
4 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAVING JURISDICTION WHERE his or her new
5 address is located ~~,~~ or the ~~state police or the sheriff's~~
6 department of the individual's new address:
7 (a) The individual changes his or her address.
8 (b) The individual is paroled.
9 (c) Final release of the individual from the jurisdiction of
10 the department of corrections.

1 (2) Within 10 days after either of the following occurs, the
2 department of corrections shall notify the local law enforcement
3 agency ~~for~~ OR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAVING JURISDICTION OVER the
4 area to which the individual is transferred ~~,~~ or the ~~state~~
5 ~~police of the sheriff's~~ department of the transferred address of
6 an individual required to be registered under this act:

7 (a) The individual is transferred to a community residential
8 program.

9 (b) The individual is transferred into a minimum custody
10 correctional facility of any kind, including a correctional camp
11 or work camp.

12 (3) ON THE FIFTEENTH DAY OF EACH MONTH, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
13 MAIL A VERIFICATION FORM TO EACH INDIVIDUAL REGISTERED UNDER THIS
14 ACT. THE FORM SHALL BE SENT FIRST-CLASS TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S REG-
15 ISTERED ADDRESS AND SHALL NOT BE FORWARDABLE. THE REGISTERED
16 INDIVIDUAL SHALL COMPLETE THE VERIFICATION FORM AND SIGN AND
17 RETURN THE FORM WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING IT. AN INDIVIDUAL
18 REGISTERED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL PAY THE DEPARTMENT THE ACTUAL
19 EXPENSES OF VERIFYING THE INDIVIDUAL'S ADDRESS UNDER THIS
20 SUBSECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY ALL INDIVIDUALS REGIS-
21 TERED UNDER THIS ACT BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY
22 ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
23 SUBSECTION.

24 (4) ~~-(3)-~~ Except as provided in subsection ~~-(4)-~~ (5), an
25 individual shall comply with this section for 25 years after the
26 date of initially registering.

1 (5) ~~(4)~~ An individual shall comply with this section for
2 life if the individual is convicted of a second or subsequent
3 listed offense after October 1, 1995 regardless of when the first
4 listed offense was committed.

5 (6) LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES AND SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENTS
6 ARE ENCOURAGED TO VERIFY ADDRESSES OF REGISTERED INDIVIDUALS,
7 CHECK COMPLIANCE WITH THIS ACT, AND REPORT ERRORS OR DISCREPAN-
8 CIES IN THE REGISTRATION OR THE COMPILATION UNDER SECTION 8(2) TO
9 THE DEPARTMENT.

10 Sec. 7. (1) A registration under this act shall be made on
11 a form provided by the department and shall be forwarded to the
12 department in the format the department prescribes. A registra-
13 tion shall contain all of the following:

14 (a) The individual's name, social security number, date of
15 birth, and address or expected address. An individual registered
16 under this act before ~~the effective date of the 1996 amendatory~~
17 ~~act that amended this section~~ APRIL 1, 1997 shall provide the
18 department with his or her date of birth upon the department's
19 request.

20 (b) A brief summary of the individual's convictions for
21 listed offenses, including where the offense occurred and the
22 original charge if the conviction was for a lesser offense.

23 (c) A complete physical description of the individual.

24 (2) A registration may contain the following:

25 (a) The individual's blood type and whether a DNA identifi-
26 cation profile of the individual is available.

1 (b) A recent photograph of the individual.

2 (3) The form used for registration under this act shall
3 contain a written statement that explains the duty of the indi-
4 vidual being registered to provide notice of a change of address
5 under section 5, ~~and~~ the procedures for providing that notice,
6 AND THE ADDRESS VERIFICATION PROCEDURES UNDER SECTION 5.

7 (4) The individual may sign the registration or notice.

8 (5) The officer, court, or an employee of the agency regis-
9 tering the individual or receiving or accepting a registration
10 under section 4 shall sign the registration form.

11 (6) An individual shall not knowingly provide false or mis-
12 leading information concerning a registration, ~~or~~ notice, OR
13 ADDRESS VERIFICATION.

14 (7) The department shall prescribe the form for a notifica-
15 tion required under section 5 and the format for forwarding the
16 notification to the department.
