SENATE BILL NO. 842

January 14, 1998, Introduced by Senator SCHUETTE and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey certain state owned property in Clare county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The department of natural resources, on behalf of
- 2 the state, may convey to Garfield township, for consideration of
- 3 \$1.00, property under the jurisdiction of the department of natu-
- 4 ral resources and located in Garfield township, Clare county,
- 5 Michigan, and further described as follows:
- 6 The South three quarters (S3/4) of the East Half (E/2) of
- 7 the Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Section 3, Garfield Township,
- 8 T17N, R6W, Clare County, Michigan
- 9 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 10 for both of the following:

- (a) That the property shall be used exclusively for public
- 2 purposes and that upon termination of that use or use for any
- 3 other purpose, the state may reenter and repossess the property,
- 4 terminating the grantee's estate in the property.
- (b) That if the grantee disputes the state's exercise of its 5
- 6 right of reentry and fails to promptly deliver possession of the
- 7 property to the state, the attorney general, on behalf of the
- 8 state, may bring an action to quiet title to, and regain posses-
- 9 sion of, the property.
- Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 11 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall convey
- 12 all rights held by the state to coal, oil, gas, and other miner-
- 13 als, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic minerals
- 14 found on or under the property conveyed.
- 15 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 16 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
