A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms possessed in violation of this act; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.434) by adding section 5a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

- 1 SEC. 5A. (1) THE CONCEALED WEAPON LICENSING BOARD SHALL

- 4 LICENSING BOARD IS NOT REQUIRED TO MEET OR CONTINUE MEETING AFTER
- 5 6 P.M. IF THERE ARE NO APPLICATIONS PENDING BEFORE THE BOARD.
