

**SENATE BILL NO. 994**

March 4, 1998, Introduced by Senators GEAKE, STILLE, GOUGEON,  
MC MANUS, NORTH, SCHUETTE, GAST, SCHWARZ, VAN REGENMORTER,  
HOFFMAN and BULLARD and referred to the Committee on  
Appropriations.

A bill to make an appropriation for the judicial branch and certain  
other state purposes for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998; and  
to provide for the expenditure of the appropriation.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the judiciary to supplement  
2 former appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, from

16       Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state consti-  
17 tution of 1963, total state spending from state sources for fiscal year  
18 1997-98 is estimated at \$216,500.00 in this act from state sources and  
19 state spending paid to local units of government for fiscal year 1997-98  
20 is estimated at \$0.

**1 JUDICIARY**

2       Sec. 301. The funds appropriated to the state court administrative  
3 office in section 101 shall be used by the state court administrative  
4 office to provide support and staff functions for friend of the court  
5 citizens advisory committees described under sections 4, 4a, 19, and 26  
6 of the friend of the court act, 1982 PA 294, MCL 552.504, 552.504a,  
7 552.519, and 552.526. The state court administrative office shall gather  
8 and monitor relevant statistics, prepare an annual grievance report,  
9 develop and provide a manual, develop and provide all necessary forms,  
10 and conduct regional annual training for citizen advisory committee  
11 members.
