

**SENATE BILL NO. 1095**

April 30, 1998, Introduced by Senators DINGELL, KOIVISTO, BERRYMAN, NORTH and JAYE and referred to the Committee on Hunting, Fishing and Forestry.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 223a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1        SEC. 223A. THIS CHAPTER DOES NOT REQUIRE A SELLER TO HAVE A  
2 FEDERAL LICENSE TO SELL OR OFFER TO SELL ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IN  
3 THIS STATE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO A SALE OR OFFER THROUGH  
4 THE INTERNET OR OTHER ELECTRONIC MEDIA OR THROUGH A NEWSPAPER,  
5 MAGAZINE, OR OTHER PRINT MEDIA:

6        (A) BLACK POWDER OR A PRODUCT SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO  
7 BLACK POWDER.

8        (B) A FIREARM THAT USES BLACK POWDER OR A PRODUCT SUBSTAN-  
9 Tially EQUIVALENT TO BLACK POWDER.

10       Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
