

**SENATE BILL NO. 1103**

May 5, 1998, Introduced by Senator DE BEAUSSAERT and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled  
"Public health code,"  
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21053d.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1        SEC. 21053D. (1) A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION SHALL  
2 PROVIDE IN EACH GROUP AND INDIVIDUAL CONTRACT BENEFITS FOR SCALP  
3 HAIR PROSTHESIS FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SCALP HAIR LOSS AS A  
4 RESULT OF ALOPECIA AREATA IF THE INDIVIDUAL'S ATTENDING PHYSICIAN  
5 CERTIFIES IN WRITING THE MEDICAL NECESSITY OF THAT PROPOSED  
6 COURSE OF REHABILITATIVE TREATMENT.  
7        (2) THE COVERAGE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO  
8 DOLLAR LIMITS, DEDUCTIBLES, AND COINSURANCE PROVISIONS THAT ARE  
9 LESS FAVORABLE THAN THOSE FOR OTHER PROSTHESIS COVERAGE.  
10 HOWEVER, A HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION MAY PROVIDE THAT THE  
11 HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION WILL ONLY PAY 80% OF THE

1 CUSTOMARY AND USUAL COSTS OF THE SCALP HAIR PROSTHESIS EXCLUSIVE  
2 OF ANY DEDUCTIBLE.

3 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SCALP HAIR PROSTHESIS"  
4 INCLUDES ANY ARTIFICIAL SUBSTITUTES FOR SCALP HAIR.

5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect  
6 December 31, 1998.
