## SENATE BILL NO. 1351

November 5, 1998, Introduced by Senators DE BEAUSSAERT, HART and BYRUM and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1310.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1310. (1) EACH SCHOOL BOARD SHALL ADOPT A WRITTEN DIS-
- 2 TRICTWIDE SCHOOL DISCIPLINE POLICY WHICH SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST
- 3 ALL OF THE MATTERS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (4).
- 4 (2) THE POLICY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEVEL-
- 5 OPED WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF ADMINISTRATORS, TEACHERS, EMPLOY-
- 6 EES, PUPILS, PARENTS, COMMUNITY MEMBERS, AND OTHER INDIVIDUALS OR
- 7 ORGANIZATIONS THE SCHOOL BOARD DETERMINES APPROPRIATE. IF A PAR-
- 8 TICULAR SCHOOL HAS A SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL CONSISTING OF THE TYPE
- 9 OF PERSONS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
- 10 SCHOOL BOARD THE SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL MAY INCLUDE PROVISIONS IN
- 11 THE POLICY IN ADDITION TO THOSE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

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- 1 (3) THE PROVISIONS OF THE POLICY REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 2 (4)(C) SHALL ESTABLISH THE VARIOUS GROUNDS FOR WHICH A PUPIL MAY
- 3 BE REMOVED FROM A CLASS FOR A PERIOD OF TIME PURSUANT TO THE PRO-
- 4 CEDURES SPECIFIED IN THE POLICY. THE GROUNDS IN THE POLICY SHALL
- 5 INCLUDE AT LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING AS WELL AS OTHER GROUNDS
- 6 DETERMINED APPROPRIATE BY THE SCHOOL BOARD:
- 7 (A) WILLFUL CONDUCT THAT MATERIALLY AND SUBSTANTIALLY DIS-
- 8 RUPTS THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS TO AN EDUCATION.
- 9 (B) WILLFUL CONDUCT THAT ENDANGERS SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOY-
- 10 EES, THE PUPIL OR OTHER PUPILS, OR THE PROPERTY OF THE SCHOOL.
- 11 (C) WILLFUL VIOLATION OF ANY RULE OF CONDUCT SPECIFIED IN
- 12 THE DISCIPLINE POLICY ADOPTED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD.
- 13 (4) THE POLICY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE AT
- 14 LEAST ALL OF THE FOLLOWING COMPONENTS:
- 15 (A) RULES GOVERNING PUPIL CONDUCT, INCLUDING THE CODE OF
- 16 STUDENT CONDUCT REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 1312(8), AND PROCEDURES
- 17 FOR INFORMING PUPILS OF THESE RULES.
- 18 (B) THE GROUNDS AND PROCEDURES FOR REMOVAL OF A PUPIL FROM A
- 19 CLASS, AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (3).
- 20 (C) THE AUTHORITY OF THE CLASSROOM TEACHER TO REMOVE PUPILS
- 21 FROM THE CLASSROOM PURSUANT TO PROCEDURES AND RULES ESTABLISHED
- 22 IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S POLICY.
- 23 (D) PROCEDURES FOR REMOVAL OF A PUPIL FROM A CLASS BY A
- 24 TEACHER, SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR, OR OTHER SCHOOL DISTRICT
- **25** EMPLOYEE.

- 1 (E) THE PERIOD OF TIME FOR WHICH A PUPIL MAY BE REMOVED FROM
- 2 A CLASS, WHICH SHALL NOT EXCEED 5 CLASS PERIODS FOR A VIOLATION
- 3 OF A RULE OF CONDUCT.
- 4 (F) PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND CUS-
- 5 TODY OF A PUPIL REMOVED FROM A CLASS.
- 6 (G) PROCEDURES FOR RETURN OF A PUPIL TO THE SPECIFIED CLASS
- 7 FROM WHICH THE PUPIL HAS BEEN REMOVED.
- 8 (H) PROCEDURES FOR NOTIFYING A PUPIL AND THE PUPIL'S PARENTS
- 9 OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES OF CONDUCT AND OF
- 10 RESULTING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS.
- 11 (I) ANY PROCEDURES DETERMINED APPROPRIATE FOR ENCOURAGING
- 12 EARLY INVOLVEMENT OF PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS IN ATTEMPTS TO
- 13 IMPROVE A PUPIL'S BEHAVIOR.
- 14 (J) ANY PROCEDURES DETERMINED APPROPRIATE FOR ENCOURAGING
- 15 EARLY DETECTION OF BEHAVIORAL PROBLEMS.
- 16 (K) ANY PROCEDURES DETERMINED APPROPRIATE FOR REFERRING A
- 17 PUPIL IN NEED OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES TO THOSE SERVICES.
- 18 (1) PROCEDURES FOR CONSIDERATION OF WHETHER THERE IS A NEED
- 19 FOR A FURTHER ASSESSMENT OR OF WHETHER THERE IS A NEED FOR A
- 20 REVIEW OF THE ADEQUACY OF A CURRENT INDIVIDUAL EDUCATION PLAN OF
- 21 A PUPIL WITH A DISABILITY WHO IS REMOVED FROM CLASS.
- 22 (M) PROCEDURES FOR DETECTING AND ADDRESSING CHEMICAL ABUSE
- 23 PROBLEMS OF A PUPIL WHILE ON THE SCHOOL PREMISES.
- 24 (N) THE MINIMUM CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES OF
- 25 CONDUCT.
- 26 (O) PROCEDURES FOR IMMEDIATE AND APPROPRIATE INTERVENTIONS
- 27 TIED TO VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES.

- 1 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL BOARD" INCLUDES THE
- 2 BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY AND "SCHOOL
- 3 DISTRICT" INCLUDES A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.

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
