A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4850 AS INTRODUCED 9-23-99

Currently, the LEIN [Law Enforcement Information Network] Policy Council Act of 1974 allows fire chiefs (or their designees) to request and receive information obtained through the Law Enforcement Information Network by a law inforcement agency for preemployment criminal convictions histories and driving records, and vehicle registration information for vehicles involved in fire or hazardous materials incidents. The bill would amend the act to allow fire chiefs also to request and receive through LEIN hazardous materials information for the safety of the public and fire department personnel.
