**CONTENT**

The bill would amend the General Property Tax Act to provide that if a taxing unit submitted a proposal to the voters on the question of imposing a new millage, or increasing or renewing an existing millage, the ballot would have to disclose fully each local unit of government to which the revenue from that millage would be disbursed. "Local unit of government" would mean a county, city, village, township, school district, intermediate school district, community college district, public library, or local authority created under State law.
