## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5805. (1) A person shall not bring or maintain an
- 2 action to recover damages for injuries to persons or property
- 3 unless, after the claim first accrued to the plaintiff or to
- 4 someone through whom the plaintiff claims, the action is com-
- 5 menced within the periods of time prescribed by this section.
- 6 (2) The period of limitations is 2 years for an action
- 7 charging assault, battery, or false imprisonment.
- 8 (3) THE PERIOD OF LIMITATIONS IS 5 YEARS FOR AN ACTION
- 9 CHARGING ASSAULT OR BATTERY BROUGHT BY A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC
