A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY THAT MAKES A REASONABLE EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION IS NOT CIVILLY OR CRIMINALLY LIABLE OR SUBJECT TO A REMEDY OR PENALTY AVAILABLE IN THIS ARTICLE FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS SECTION].
  - [(2) A HOLDER OF MEDICAL RECORDS OR OTHER HEALTH CARE INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THE MINOR MAY CHARGE THE PERSON MAKING THE REQUEST FOR RECORDS A REASONABLE AMOUNT TO REDACT INFORMATION IN THE REQUESTED MEDICAL RECORDS OR INFORMATION.]
  - [Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1, 2000.]
