

**House Bill No. 4929**

(As amended October 28, 1999)

A bill to amend 1956 PA 62, entitled

"An act to authorize the director of the department of state police to promulgate a uniform traffic code; to authorize a city, township, or village to adopt the uniform traffic code by reference without publication in full; and to prescribe criminal penalties and civil sanctions for violation of the code,"

(MCL 257.951 to 257.954) by adding section 5.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1        SEC. 5. (1) A CIVIL FINE IMPOSED UPON A PERSON OPERATING A  
2 COMMERCIAL VEHICLE FOR A VIOLATION OF A CODE OR ORDINANCE ADOPTED  
3 BY A CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE UNDER SECTION 1 SHALL BE [ALLOCATED  
4 AS FOLLOWS:

5        (A) THIRTY PERCENT TO THE CITY, VILLAGE, OR COUNTY FOR REPAIR  
6 AND MAINTENANCE ON LOCAL ROADS. IF THE CITATION IS ISSUED UNDER  
7 TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE, THE COUNTY SHALL ALLOCATE THE FUNDS FOR REPAIR  
8 AND MAINTENANCE ON LOCAL ROADS WITHIN THAT TOWNSHIP.
