

**SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5187**

A bill to amend 1979 PA 53, entitled

"An act to prohibit access to computers, computer systems, and computer networks for certain fraudulent purposes; to prohibit intentional and unauthorized access, alteration, damage, and destruction of computers, computer systems, computer networks, computer software programs, and data; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 752.792), as amended by 1996 PA 326.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. (1) "Access" means to instruct, communicate with,
2 store data in, retrieve or intercept data from, or otherwise use
3 the resources of a computer program, computer, computer system,
4 or computer network.

5 (2) "Aggregate amount" means any direct or indirect loss
6 incurred by a victim OR GROUP OF VICTIMS including, but not
7 limited to, the value of any money, property or service lost,
8 stolen, or rendered unrecoverable by the offense, or any actual

1 expenditure incurred by the victim OR GROUP OF VICTIMS to verify
2 that a computer program, computer, computer system, or computer
3 network was not altered, acquired, damaged, deleted, disrupted,
4 or destroyed by the access. THE DIRECT OR INDIRECT LOSSES
5 INCURRED IN SEPARATE INCIDENTS PURSUANT TO A SCHEME OR COURSE OF
6 CONDUCT WITHIN ANY 12-MONTH PERIOD MAY BE AGGREGATED TO DETERMINE
7 THE TOTAL VALUE OF THE LOSS INVOLVED IN THE VIOLATION OF THIS
8 ACT.

9 (3) "Computer" means any connected, directly interoperable
10 or interactive device, equipment, or facility that uses a com-
11 puter program or other instructions to perform specific opera-
12 tions including logical, arithmetic, or memory functions with or
13 on computer data or a computer program and that can store,
14 retrieve, alter, or communicate the results of the operations to
15 a person, computer program, computer, computer system, or com-
16 puter network.

17 (4) "Computer network" means the interconnection of hardwire
18 or wireless communication lines with a computer through remote
19 terminals, or a complex consisting of 2 or more interconnected
20 computers.

21 (5) "Computer program" means a series of internal or exter-
22 nal instructions communicated in a form acceptable to a computer
23 that directs the functioning of a computer, computer system, or
24 computer network in a manner designed to provide or produce pro-
25 ducts or results from the computer, computer system, or computer
26 network.

1 (6) "Computer system" means a set of related, connected or
2 unconnected, computer equipment, devices, software, or hardware.

3 (7) "Device" includes, but is not limited to, an electronic,
4 magnetic, electrochemical, biochemical, hydraulic, optical, or
5 organic object that performs input, output, or storage functions
6 by the manipulation of electronic, magnetic, or other impulses.

7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect
8 July 1, 2000.

9 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take
10 effect unless all of the following bills of the 90th Legislature
11 are enacted into law:
