## PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

### 19 GENERAL SECTIONS

20 Sec. 201. (1) Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
21 constitution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal year  
22 1998-1999 is \$148,383,000.00 and state appropriations to be paid to local  
23 units of government are as follows:

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1       (2) If it appears to the principal executive officer of a department  
2 or branch that state spending to local units of government will be less  
3 than the amount that was projected to be expended under subsection (1),  
4 the principal executive officer shall immediately give notice of the  
5 approximate shortfall to the state budget director.

6       Sec. 202. The expenditures and funding sources authorized under  
7 this bill are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL  
8 18.1101 to 18.1594.

**9 CAPITAL OUTLAY**

10       Sec. 301. The \$3,300,000.00 in resources appropriated in section  
11 102 for recreation bond projects represent a portion of the final  
12 projected balance of 1988 recreation bond fund resources and is desig-  
13 nated for state park projects. This amount shall be used to supplement  
14 the funding provided from the clean Michigan initiative and shall be used  
15 in the manner prescribed for the respective programs in 1998 PA 286, MCL  
16 324.71601 to 324.71607, and 1998 PA 288, MCL 324.19601 to 324.19616.

**17 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY**

18       Sec. 401. (1) In addition to the funds appropriated in part 1 for  
19 environmental cleanup and redevelopment, leaking underground storage tank  
20 cleanup, and the contaminated lake and river sediments cleanup programs,  
21 the department of environmental quality is authorized to expend amounts  
22 remaining from prior fiscal year appropriations to meet funding needs of  
23 legislatively approved sites.

1       (2) Unexpended and unencumbered amounts remaining from  
2 appropriations from the environmental protection bond fund contained in  
3 1989 PA 180, 1990 PA 55, 1990 PA 194, 1991 PA 31, 1991 PA 160, 1993 PA  
4 74, 1993 PA 353, 1994 PA 442, 1996 PA 353, and 1997 PA 114 are appropri-  
5 ated for expenditure for any site listed in this bill and any site listed  
6 in the public acts referenced under this section.

7       (3) Unexpended and unencumbered amounts remaining from appropria-  
8 tions from the cleanup and redevelopment fund and unclaimed bottle depos-  
9 its fund contained in 1996 PA 319, 1997 PA 113, 1997 PA 114, and 1998 PA  
10 292 are appropriated for expenditure for any site listed in this bill and  
11 any site listed in the public acts referenced under this section.

12       (4) Unexpended and unencumbered amounts remaining from appropria-  
13 tions from the clean Michigan initiative fund - response activities fund  
14 are appropriated for expenditure for any site listed in this bill and any  
15 site listed in the public acts referenced under this section.

16       Sec. 402. (1) The department shall report all of the following  
17 information relative to allocations in part 1 for the environmental  
18 cleanup and redevelopment program, state cleanup, emergency actions,  
19 superfund cleanup, and revitalization revolving loan fund, the Brownfield  
20 grants and loans program, the NPL - municipal landfill match grants program,  
21 the waterfront  
22 redevelopment grant program, the leaking underground storage tank cleanup  
23 program, the contaminated lake and river sediments cleanup program, the  
24 nonpoint source pollution prevention and control projects program, and  
25 the environmental projects under section 19508(7) of the natural  
26 resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.19508,  
27 to the state budget director, the senate and house of representatives  
appropriations subcommittees on environmental quality, and the senate and  
house fiscal agencies:



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1 (a) The name and location of the site for which an allocation is  
2 made.

3 (b) The nature of the problem encountered at the site.

4 (c) A brief description of how the problem will be resolved if the  
5 allocation is made for a response activity.

6 (d) The estimated time to complete the activities for project  
7 closure.

8 (e) The amount of the allocation, or the anticipated financing for  
9 the site.

10 (f) A summary of the sites and the total amount of funds expended at  
11 the sites at the conclusion of the fiscal year.

12 (g) The number of sites that would qualify as brownfields that were  
13 redeveloped.

14 (2) The report shall be made available by March 31 of each year.

15 Sec. 403. The unexpended portions of the appropriation in part 1  
16 for the department of environmental quality listed in this section are  
17 considered work project appropriations. The purpose of these projects is  
18 to provide redevelopment and contaminated site cleanup and pollution pre-  
19 vention control to be accomplished through contractual services with  
20 estimated completion dates of September 30, 2003. The projects are as  
21 follows:

22 (a) Environmental cleanup and redevelopment program (estimated cost  
23 \$47,856,000.00).

24 (b) Waterfront redevelopment grant program (estimated cost  
25 \$20,000,000.00).

26 (c) Leaking underground storage tank cleanup program (estimated cost  
27 \$12,597,000.00).

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1 (d) Contaminated lake and river sediments cleanup program (estimated  
2 cost \$4,300,000.00).

3 (e) Nonpoint source pollution prevention and control projects pro-  
4 gram (estimated cost \$12,000,000.00).

5 (f) Small business pollution prevention loans (estimated cost  
6 \$5,000,000.00).

(g) Brownfield grants and loans program (estimated cost  
\$10,000,000.00).

(h) NPL - municipal landfill match grants program (estimated cost  
\$2,000,000.00).

7 Sec. 404. From the appropriation in part 1 for the program under  
8 part 196 of the natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994  
9 PA 451, MCL 324.19601 to 324.19616, clean Michigan initiative fund pro-  
10 gram, the department shall continue to make authorizations for response  
11 activities at brownfield redevelopment and environmental cleanup sites  
12 and for the administration of the program created by part 196 of the nat-  
13 ural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL  
14 324.19601 to 324.19616.
